We want to get an idea of numbers for the fall and not be short on coaches and be prepared.

Rocky stressed to coaches that they need to tell parents to email to be fair on who is the first through thirty. All coaches were very responsive in doing the extra responsibility. Trying to be proactive. Mike Conway commented that we need to have the information on the web site.

July 5<sup>th</sup> starts weekly skates then the week long skates after that. The goalies will have a week long camp with Kelly Gee the new Goalie Director. Goalie clinics start this Sunday.

Advanced Arenas will be offering discounts to HHC teams for fall tournaments.

**FACILITY UPDATE** –Everything is going great. Locker rooms need to have plumbing finished, the edging of the rinks are being poured. Please tell membership that they cannot go into the facility as of yet. It is a liability issue and safety issue, just drive by and check the website for pictures. We are working on getting Wifi for the rink as well.
